

Regulations for the UM “Silver Jubilee Cup”

1. **Objectives:** To celebrate UM’s 25th Anniversary and to display and witness her hard work and achievements through the art of photography.
2. **Requirements:**

Content: Any works capturing the University’s facilities, scenes or activities will be accepted.

Eligible Participants: All interested parties are welcome, including professionals and amateurs.

Photo Requirements: All kinds of works, black & white or color, taken by film camera or digital camera.

Photo Size: 20cm x 25cm (8”x10”). Each photo must be framed in a black card (10”x12”).

Maximum submission per person: No Limit.

Participant Identification: A participant must provide the number and topic of his/her work, his/her name, address and contact number(s) on the reverse, together with the application form.
3. **Submission Deadline:** December 1st 2006
4. **Receiving Address:** UM Student Affairs Office (Room A106, Administrative Building)
5. **Judging Panel:** The panel members will be experts invited by the Organizer.
6. **Result Announcement:** The winners will be informed by letters.
7. **Prizes:**

Champion:	a cup and MOP5,000
1 st Runner-up:	a cup and MOP2,000
2 nd Runner-up:	a cup and MOP1,000
Best Photo Award for Staff (Maximum 3)	a cup and MOP1,000
Best Photo Award for Alumni (Maximum 3)	a cup and MOP1,000
Best Photo Award for University Students (Maximum 3)	a cup and MOP1,000
Best Photo Award for Secondary School Students (Maximum 3)	a cup and MOP1,000
Twenty Excellent Photo prizes:	a certificate and MOP300 each
8. **Additional Terms:**
 - a) To encourage participation, the Champion, 1st Runner-up, 2nd Runner-up will be awarded to different participants. One participant may receive maximally two Excellent Photo prizes.
 - b) Contestants for Best Photo Award for Staff shall be staff members of UM. Contestants for Best Photo Award for Alumni shall be graduates from the full-time programmes of UM. Contestants for Best Photo Award for University Students shall be current full-time students of UM. Contestants for Best Photo Award for Secondary School Students shall be current full-time secondary school students of Macau.
 - c) Participants must accept these regulations and the decision of the judging panel.
 - d) The organizer reserves the right to reject any work that does not meet the requirement.
 - e) The organizer has the right to use any participating work for the publishing purpose in the name of the respective author without paying any fees.
 - f) The organizer will retain all the works submitted, and may request the participants to lend the film or digital file for amplification.
 - g) The organizer has the right to use the participating works in any situation, time and way.
